DANCING SYLLABUS

Adjudicator: Conor Hayes ADCRG, Melbourne, Australia

Entry fees: except where otherwise stated a flat rate of \$10.00 to be paid by a dancer to enable them to enter any dancing, poetry, oratory, drama, storytelling, singing or instrumental sections.

Age: taken as at 1st January.

The Ulster Cup and International Travel Scholarship

301 18+ years Ulster Cup (Jig)

Rodney H C Walshe OMNZ, the Honorary Consul General for Ireland in New Zealand will provide a travel scholarship to the winner of the Ulster Cup up to the value of NZD\$2,500 towards the cost of air travel to an approved international dancing event being held in the year immediately following the receipt of the Scholarship.

Selection: Any TIDA New Zealand registered dancer in the approved age group is eligible for this scholarship, except that no dancer can win the scholarship more than twice, not necessarily in succession. The International Judge officiating at the annual feis will select the Scholarship winner, and is the sole Judge of this Scholarship.

Tuition Scholarship

302 15 and Under 18 years Tuition Scholarship (Set Dance)

The National Feis Committee will provide a scholarship to the value of \$500.. The dancing school of the winner will receive a payment of \$500 towards the cost of the winner's tuition fees for the forthcoming year.

Selection: Any TIDA New Zealand registered dancer in the approved age group is eligible for this scholarship.
